





Instituto Comida e Cultura and Instituto de Estudos Avançados host seminar on food and nutrition education at São Paulo University

Event addresses the strategic role of Food and Nutrition Education in the context of the climate crisis, social inequalities, and disinformation

On **August 11**, the seminar "A Hora e a Vez da EAN" ("The Time for Food and Nutrition Education [FNE] is Now") will take place, organized through a partnership between the Instituto Comida e Cultura (ICC) and the Institute of Advanced Studies (IEA) at the University of São Paulo (USP). The event, also supported by the Alfredo Bosi Chair for Basic Education at USP, aims to place Food and Nutrition Education (FNE) at the center of debates on education, food culture, health, and social justice.

Featuring panels and conversations among experts to discuss public policies, educational practices, and the role of food in promoting equity and citizenship, the seminar will run from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. at IEA-USP, located in the USP campus, with a live broadcast on YouTube.

"This event represents a powerful articulation between civil society, academia, and public authorities to strengthen Food and Nutrition Education as an ongoing practice in schools and as a public policy with cross-sectoral impact. Our goal is to broaden this conversation, raise awareness among decision-makers, and support educators in building a positive and transformative agenda to ensure the Human Right to Adequate Food," said Patrícia Jaime, Vice Director of the USP School of Public Health and researcher at IEA.

During the seminar, the manifesto "The Time for Food and Nutrition Education" will be launched. This document advocates for FNE as a structural public policy in the context of the global syndemic — the intersection of multiple epidemics such as obesity, undernutrition, noncommunicable diseases, and climate change. It also presents seven recommendations for public managers to effectively implement FNE in schools. Access the full document here (only in Portuguese, for now).

The seminar is aimed at professionals in education, health, social assistance, and agriculture, as well as teachers, undergraduate and graduate students, researchers, policymakers, and representatives of social movements and organized civil society.
